## SUSPENSION LETTER

Dear Bishop Paul,

Your actions last Sunday at the Divine Liturgy has prompted this letter of Suspension. You are hereby suspended from all ecclesiastical duties for a period of 30 days. You are suspended from all of the Divine services. If you insist to celebrate the Divine services with any other clergyman you will be deposed. If there is true repentance from your actions last Sunday the suspension will be lifted. If you do not repent from your actions, a Spiritual Court will be convened with the Holy Synod to issue a deposition to the rank of laity.

During the Divine Liturgy last Sunday, you left in the middle of the service which has violated (2) of the Holy Orthodox Canons. No matter what the reason you felt justified to leave, you never abandon the altar of the Lord. It appeared you chose your friend over the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Canons violated are listed below:

## Canon VIII of the 85 Canons of the Holy Apostles

If any Bishop, or Presbyter, or Deacon, or anyone else in the sacerdotal list, fail to partake of communion when the oblation has been offered, he must tell the reason; and if it is good excuse, he shall receive a pardon. But if he refuses to tell it, he shall be excommunicated, on the ground that he has become a cause of harm to the laity and has instilled a suspicion as against the offerer of it that the latter has failed to present it in a sound manner.

## Canon IX of the 85 Canons of the Holy Apostles

All those faithful who enter and listen to the Scriptures, but do not stay for prayer and Holy Communion must be excommunicated, on the ground that they are causing the Church a breach of order.

May the Lord have mercy on you.
